PROJECT INFORMATION

CLEAN or Technologies and open innovation for low-carbon regions project will address the challenge of how to best meet EU energy efficiency targets for buildings in Europe's regions. The CLEAN project is led by ERNACT, or European Regions Network for the Application of Communications Technology, with close cooperation from the partners in the project. The regions will work together between 2017–2021 to improve the capacity of their policy instruments to increase energy efficiency. These regions are represented by a mix of regional partners including managing authorities, region/city authorities and energy centres.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

Buildings are responsible for 40 percent of energy consumption in the EU and older buildings consume between 8 and 12 times as much energy as new ones. CLEAN will increase energy efficiency in housing and public infrastructure by 4 percent through technology, open innovation and improved low-carbon policy instruments.

- Energy consumption is still increasing in the EU 28
- Renewable energy has increased to about 17 percent (2016)
- The target is 20 percent energy-efficiency by 2020
