PROJECT INFORMATION

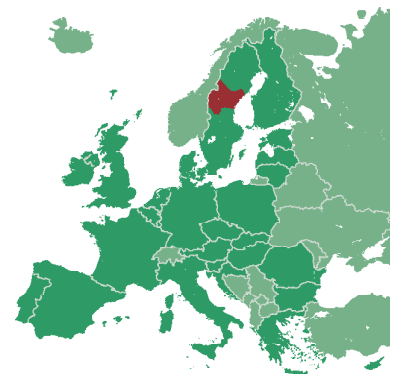
The e-collaboration project involves nine municipalities in the middle of Sweden. The municipalities have made a joint effort in development of new digital services, methodologies for needs-driven development, management and improvement in collaboration models. The collaboration also contains methodology support for implementation and various professional development activities. Furthermore, there is ongoing work with an e-library service that makes e-services that a municipality has developed available to other municipalities with or without specific adaptation. The technical platform was partly developed earlier in a EU-funded project called RIGES. The project also cooperates with Swedish Association of Local Authorities and Regions in terms of integration of e-services on a national level. The Association of Local Authorities in Västernorrland County's projects IMPROVE and ERUDITE are two other examples in which eSamverkan collaborates regarding skills development and evaluation methods. There is also a common exchange with some twenty other municipalities in implementing e-development on the platform. The mission of e-Collaboration is directly in line with the Swedish government's action plan for 2020, SKL's strategy for e-society and the national and regional digital agenda. The work in the project has a strong focus on capacity-increasing activities for the participants.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- Create fully automated e-services – and provide sufficient tools to increase resources for the municipalities' core activities.
- Find forms to engage the community and arrange business development activities in support of digitizing.
- Provide project and asset management - ensure clear assignments and access to support for development and change within the organization.
- Obtain long-term and stable conditions for running the platforms.
- Allocate time resources, competencies and financing for all objectives above.
