



LITERACY PROGRAM FOR STREET CHILDREN

Glad House is an NGO which supports street connected children



- ▶ Use sports to reach youth on the streets between (15 – 19 years) and latter recruit them in non formal education centre in Magongo.
 - ▶ Sell bicycles from United Kingdom and repair to get funding
 - ▶ Depend on donations from other organizations
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1. Street Soccer

- ▶ Played on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday
 - ▶ Coaches bring balls.
 - ▶ Children play and are engaged by social workers– collect data and plan on intervention strategies
 - ▶ Informal school in Magongo employed teachers too children
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ii) Papasa

- ▶ Children on the street trust no one
- ▶ They are taught how to stay without drugs
- ▶ play football to reduce the drug level
- ▶ Social workers take them through counseling
- ▶ They go to class & their fare is paid for them
- ▶ The addicts who change are taken to school and informal sector for jobs.

iii) Boxing Program

- ▶ Target between (17 – 24 years). Fifteen (15) youth in nine (9) months
- ▶ Put in residential centre called transition home
- ▶ Sixteen (16) kilometres 3 days a week – Monday, Wednesday and Friday
- ▶ Train in boxing twice a day from 9.00 am – 11.45 am and 5.00pm – 6.45 pm.
- ▶ Go to class at after 11.45 am and resume class at 2.00pm
